Indiana

Background

On January 7, 2021, Indiana Representative Greg Porter (D) proposed HB 1177 to create a state-wide strategic plan on dementia. The proposed bill would establish the Indiana dementia council and requires the council to submit a report to the governor's office and the general assembly concerning dementia, research on Alzheimer's disease, and the outcomes of implementing the dementia strategic plan.

Action Item

While this is a good initiative, the proposed dementia council does not include representation from residential care facilities (currently, there is just one member "from assisted living" industry). If RAL homes are not represented on the council, it is very likely that the council will propose solutions that do not take the RAL industry's viewpoints into account.
